Dr. Leslie M. Randall is the Diane Harris Wright Professor of Gynecologic Oncology at Virginia Commonwealth University and the National Cancer Institute (NCI)-Designated Massey Cancer Center. She completed her medical training at the University of Louisville and her Gynecologic Oncology subspecialty training at the University of California Irvine where she remained on faculty for 10 years. She is Board-Certified to deliver comprehensive medical and surgical care to women with all gynecologic cancers.

Dr. Randall's research interests focus on the investigation of new cancer treatments and new imaging techniques. She holds a master's degree in Advanced Clinical Research and serves as the Principal Investigator of multiple clinical trials and on the scientific steering committees of several other national and international trials. She is currently a member of the NCI-sponsored NRG Oncology Group Ovarian Cancer and Developmental Therapeutics Committees, serves as the Cervical Cancer Clinical Trial Advisor for the GOG Partners group, and sits on the Board of Directors for the Gynecologic Oncology Group (GOG) Foundation.
